Dear Administrator Power,

**Letter to USAID Administrator, Samantha Power, from 1289 local civil society actors (EN)**

As local civil society actors from the Global South, we followed your speech at Georgetown University earlier this month with great interest. We were inspired by your commitment to make US foreign assistance more accessible, equitable, and responsive to local actors. We welcome your goal to center local voices in USAID's work to counter existing inequities. We thank you for committing 25 per cent of all USAID funding to local actors over the next four years. We applaud your dedication to ensure that, by the end of this decade, 50 per cent of USAID programming will be driven by local communities.

For many years, civil society has played a crucial role in sustaining justice, peace and inclusion and leading the implementation of humanitarian, development, and peacebuilding action in our communities. The vital part we played during the global COVID-19 crisis is unquestionable, including our efforts to rebuild societies post-crisis, in which future generations can thrive.

However, our actions, legitimacy, experience and knowledge have mostly been ignored by bilateral and multilateral donors. Indeed, the relationship that international actors have had with us so far is often highly extractive and not mutually beneficial, nor has the playing field for access to funding been as equitable as it should have been. Localization commitments have often been translated into the tokenistic inclusion of local actors in a few official ceremonies, global frameworks, and policy discussions - a privilege that is available for a limited number of us. We have too often been relegated to the role of implementing partners, rather than independent actors in our own right, without the ability to make decisions on the kinds of support our communities need and value, considering their realities and visions for change. Meanwhile, investing directly in bottom-up, locally-led initiatives is the best way to ensure relevance, legitimacy, ownership and durability of any solution, using fewer resources and in ways that can be scaled up in different contexts, than those led by intermediaries.

We therefore ask you, by way of this open letter, to:

1. **Speak directly with us.** We are ready - and expect - to collaborate with USAID in order to help make these commitments a reality and better agree strategies for cooperation, by creating channels and structures for consultation and shared decision-making. Strengthened direct collaboration will ensure USAID centers local action and increases the impact of both your work and ours.
2. **Ensure funding reaches many, diverse, and truly local organisations.** This requires USAID to revise definitions of who is local. Current USAID funding practices often result in a few national branches of international NGOs presenting themselves as "local" and absorbing the majority of international resources available to our civil society. This can lead to a situation where those INGOs absorb funding intended for truly local organisations and end up speaking to you, for us, without us and reinforce the status quo.
3. **Invest in local civil society coordination mechanisms.** Competition for resources has damaged important connections within local civil society. Alongside the additional resources USAID will provide in the next years, we ask for necessary investments that help to rebuild our collective strength to meet the needs of our communities, together, through joint civil society coordination mechanisms at the national and local level.



4. **Invest in institutional strengthening of local civil society.** USAID funding is mostly for sectoral programmes or based on themes; but there is also a need to support the sustainability of local groups, including institutional capacities of civil society, by offering flexible, predictable funding and other support for institutional development. This should actively include groups engaged in advocacy, lobbying, organising and mobilising work.
5. **Simplify funding management.** Complex USAID funding applications and granting processes have been a barrier for many of us. In order to be more accessible and to reach a diverse range of local partners, it is important USAID adapts administrative and project management to local knowledge and expertise at a systematic level. In addition, USAID should invest in strengthening the institutional capacity and due diligence process of local partners so that they are able to be grant ready.
6. **Build practical solutions for USAID to meet its new targets.** This could include new locally-led financing models that will allow USAID to address their capacity constraints, such as nationally pooled funds led by civil society.

For these reasons, and in light of your welcome commitments, it is essential that your key collaborators in this exciting new effort are truly “local actors.” We are ready and eager to be part of this process of identifying the best ways to make these changes. Madame l'Administratrice,

**Lettre à l'administratrice de l'USAID, Samantha Power, des 1289 groupes locaux de société civile (FR)**

En tant qu'acteurs de la société civile des pays du Sud, nous avons suivi avec grand intérêt votre discours prononcé à l'Université de Georgetown au début du mois. Nous avons été inspirés par votre volonté de rendre l'aide des Etas Unis plus accessible, équitable et adaptée aux acteurs locaux. Nous vous félicitons de centrer les voix locales dans le travail de l'USAID pour contrer les inégalités existantes. Nous vous remercions d'avoir alloué aux acteurs locaux le 25% de tous les financements de l'USAID pour les quatre prochaines années. Nous applaudissons aussi votre dévouement pour garantir que, d'ici la fin de cette décennie, 50% de la programmation de l'USAID sera conduite par les communautés locales.

Pendant de nombreuses années, la société civile a joué un rôle crucial dans nos communautés pour assurer justice, paix, inclusion mais aussi pour la mise en œuvre d'actions humanitaires, de développement et de consolidation de la paix. Le rôle vital que nous avons joué pendant la crise mondiale du COVID-19 est incontestable, y compris nos efforts pour reconstruire des sociétés après la crise, dans lesquelles les générations futures peuvent prospérer.

Cependant, nos actions, notre légitimité, notre expérience et nos connaissances ont été pour la plupart ignorées par les donateurs bilatéraux et multilatéraux. En effet, la relation que les acteurs internationaux ont eue avec nous jusqu'à présent est souvent très extractive et non mutuellement bénéfique, et les modalités pour l'accès aux financements n'ont pas été aussi équitables qu'ils auraient dû l'être. Les efforts de localisation se sont souvent traduits par une inclusion symbolique d'acteurs locaux dans quelques cérémonies officielles, cadres mondiaux et discussions politiques - un privilège accordé à un nombre limité d'entre nous. Nous avons trop souvent été relégués au rôle de partenaires de mise en œuvre, plutôt que d'acteurs indépendants à part entière. Il nous a été impossible de prendre des décisions sur les types de soutien nécessaire et appréciés de nos communautés, en tenant compte de leurs réalités et de leurs visions du changement. Investir directement dans des initiatives ascendantes dirigées par groupes locaux au lieu de celles dirigées par des intermédiaires est un meilleur moyen d'assurer la pertinence, la légitimité, l'appropriation et la durabilité de toute solution. De cette manière, nous garantissons également l'utilisation de moindre des ressources et l'extension de cette expérience à différents contextes.

Nous vous demandons donc, par la présente de :

1. **Parler directement avec nous.** Nous sommes prêts - et comptons - collaborer avec l'USAID afin de faire de ces engagements une réalité et de mieux convenir des stratégies de coopération, en créant des canaux et des structures de consultation et de prise de décision partagée. Une collaboration directe renforcée garantira que l'USAID centre l'action locale et augmente l'impact de nos missions respectives.
2. **Veiller à ce que le financement atteigne beaucoup d'organisations, diverses et véritablement locales.** Cela nécessite que l'USAID révise les définitions de qui est local. Les pratiques de financement actuelles de l'USAID ont souvent pour résultat que quelques branches nationales d'ONG internationales se présentent comme « locales » et absorbent la majorité des ressources internationales disponibles pour notre société civile. Cela peut conduire à une situation où ces ONG internationales absorbent des fonds destinés à des organisations vraiment locales et finissent par vous parler, sur nous, sans nous et renforcent le statu quo.



**3. Investir dans les mécanismes de coordination de la société civile locale.** La concurrence pour les ressources a affaibli des liens importants au sein de la société civile locale. Parallèlement aux ressources supplémentaires que l'USAID fournira au cours des prochaines années, nous demandons les investissements nécessaires à reconstruire notre force collective pour répondre aux besoins de nos communautés, ensemble, grâce à des mécanismes de coordination conjoints de la société civile aux niveaux national et local.

**4. Investir dans le renforcement institutionnel de la société civile locale.** L'aide financière de l'USAID se dirige principalement vers des programmes sectoriels ou thématiques ; mais il est également nécessaire de soutenir la durabilité des groupes locaux, y compris les capacités institutionnelles de la société civile, en offrant un financement flexible et prévisible et d'autres formes de soutien au développement institutionnel. Cela devrait inclure aussi les groupes engagés dans le travail de plaidoyer, de lobbying, d'organisation communautaire et de mobilisation.

**5. Simplifier la gestion du financement.** Les demandes de financement et les processus d'octroi complexes de l'USAID ont été un obstacle pour beaucoup d'entre nous. Afin d'être plus accessible et d'atteindre un large éventail de partenaires locaux, il est important que l'USAID adapte la gestion administrative et de projet aux connaissances et à l'expertise locales à un niveau systématique. En outre, l'USAID devrait investir dans le renforcement de la capacité institutionnelle et du processus de diligence raisonnable des partenaires locaux afin qu'ils puissent être prêts à recevoir des subventions.

**6. Construire des solutions pratiques pour l'USAID afin d'atteindre ses nouveaux objectifs.** Cela pourrait inclure de nouveaux modèles de financement dirigés localement qui permettront à l'USAID de faire face à ses contraintes de capacité, telles que les fonds mis en commun au niveau national dirigés par la société civile.

Pour ces raisons, et en raison de votre engagement public, il est essentiel que vos collaborateurs plus proches dans ce nouvel effort soient véritablement des « acteurs locaux ». Nous sommes prêts et impatients de faire partie de ce processus d'identification des meilleures façons d'apporter ces changements.

Apreciada Administradora Power,

**Carta a la administradora de USAID Samantha Power de parte de 1289 grupos de la sociedad civil local (ES)**

Como actores de la sociedad civil del Sur Global, hemos seguido con gran interés su discurso en la Universidad de Georgetown a principios de este mes. Nos inspiró su compromiso para hacer que la ayuda internacional de los Estados Unidos sea más accesible, equitativa y adaptada a las necesidades de los actores locales. Agradecemos su objetivo de poner al centro del trabajo de USAID las voces locales para hacer frente a las actuales desigualdades. Le agradecemos por destinar el 25% de todos los fondos de USAID a los actores locales durante los próximos cuatro años. Aplaudimos su dedicación para garantizar que, para fines de esta década, el 50% de la programación de USAID sea dirigida por y para comunidades locales.

Durante muchos años, la sociedad civil ha jugado un papel crucial en nuestras comunidades para mantener justicia, paz y inclusión así como liderando acciones humanitarias, de desarrollo y de consolidación de la paz. El papel vital que hemos desempeñado durante la crisis mundial de COVID-19 es incuestionable, y lo será también nuestro rol para reconstruir sociedades en las que las generaciones futuras puedan prosperar.

Sin embargo, nuestras acciones, legitimidad, experiencia y conocimiento han sido en gran parte ignorados por los donantes bilaterales y multilaterales. De hecho, la relación que los actores internacionales han tenido con nosotros hasta ahora ha sido más bien extractiva y no mutuamente beneficiosa, ni las modalidades para el acceso a la financiación tan equitativas como deberían haberlo sido. Los compromisos de localización se han traducido a menudo en una inclusión simbólica de actores locales en algunas ceremonias oficiales, marcos globales y discusiones políticas, un privilegio que ha sido otorgado a pocos entre nosotros. Con demasiada frecuencia hemos sido relegados al papel de socios implementadores en lugar de actores independientes y por derecho propio, sin poder tomar decisiones sobre los tipos de apoyo que nuestras comunidades más necesitan y valoran, considerando sus realidades y visiones de cambio. Invertir directamente en iniciativas desde abajo y lideradas localmente, en lugar de iniciativas lideradas por intermediarios, es la mejor manera de asegurar la relevancia, legitimidad, apropiación y sostenibilidad de cualquier solución, utilizando menos recursos y asegurando su posible ampliación en diferentes contextos.

Por tanto, a través de esta carta, pedimos que:

- 1. Se hable directamente con nosotrxs.** Estamos listxs, y esperamos, colaborar con USAID para ayudar a hacer realidad estos compromisos y para acordar mejores estrategias de cooperación, mediante la creación de canales y estructuras para la consulta y la toma de decisiones compartida. Una más estrecha colaboración directa garantizará que USAID centre la acción local y aumente el impacto tanto de su trabajo como del nuestro.
- 2. Los fondos lleguen a muchas y diversas organizaciones que sean verdaderamente locales.** Esto requiere que USAID revise las definiciones de quién es local. Las prácticas actuales de financiamiento de USAID a menudo consienten que algunas ramas nacionales de ONG internacionales se califiquen como “locales” y absorban la mayoría de los recursos internacionales disponibles para nuestra sociedad civil. Esto puede llevar a una situación en la que esas ONGs internacionales absorban fondos destinados a organizaciones verdaderamente locales y terminen hablando sobre nosotrxs, sin nosotrxs, y reforzando el status quo.



3. **Se invierta en mecanismos de coordinación de la sociedad civil local.** La competencia por los recursos ha lastimado importantes relaciones dentro de la sociedad civil local. Junto a los recursos adicionales que USAID proporcionará en los próximos años, solicitamos inversiones para ayudar a reconstruir nuestra fuerza colectiva haciendo frente común a las necesidades de nuestras comunidades a través de mecanismos de coordinación de la sociedad civil a nivel nacional y local.

4. **Se invierta en el fortalecimiento institucional de la sociedad civil local.** El financiamiento de USAID está destinado principalmente a programas sectoriales o temáticos; pero también es necesario apoyar la sostenibilidad de los grupos locales y fortalecer sus capacidades institucionales, ofreciendo financiación flexible y predecible y otros tipos de apoyo para el desarrollo institucional, inclusive para grupos más comprometidos en cabildeo, incidencia y movilización.

5. **Se simplifique la gestión de la financiación.** Las complejas solicitudes y los procesos de asignación de USAID han sido una barrera para muchos de nosotros. Para ser más accesible y llegar a una amplia gama de actores locales, es importante que USAID adapte sistemáticamente la gestión administrativa y de proyectos al conocimiento y experiencia locales. Además, USAID debería invertir en el fortalecimiento de la capacidad y en procesos de debida diligencia de sus socios locales para que estos puedan manejar subvenciones.

6. **Se construyan soluciones prácticas para que USAID cumpla con sus nuevos objetivos.** Esto podría incluir nuevos modelos de financiamiento liderados localmente que permitirían a USAID abordar sus limitaciones de capacidad, como los fondos mancomunados a nivel nacional liderados por la sociedad civil.

Por estas razones, y en relación con sus compromisos públicos, es esencial que sus colaboradores más cercanos para este desafío sean verdaderamente "actores locales". Quedamos disponibles y encantados en ser parte del proceso de identificación y realización de estos cambios.
